

Volunteer Duties/Expectations – Game Crew

Props Crew: (**Note – Heavy lifting/pushing/pulling may be required**)

- Transfer props (including long ranger and Drum Major podium) from band hall (or equipment trailer for away games/contests) to the sidelines prior to the start of the game/contest
- Transfer props(including long ranger and Drum Major podium) from sidelines to the appropriate location on the field for the half-time performance and back off the field after the performance
- Transfer props(including long ranger and Drum Major podium) from sidelines to band hall (or equipment trailer) at the conclusion of the game/contest

Water/3rd Quarter Snack Crew:

- Before the game/contest, ensure that water coolers are filled with ice water and drinks for 3rd quarter snack are iced down in large white cooler. Also, gather snacks for 3rd quarter
- Make sure First Aid Kit is on the water cart
- Transport water cart, ice chest, and snacks to the field (or trailer) prior to game or contest and back to band hall at the conclusion of the game
- Distribute water to the band members throughout the duration of the game (have water ready for distribution as soon as the band is seated in the stands)
- Distribute drinks/snack during 3rd quarter
- Monitor band members for signs of over-heating or dehydration. Administer First Aid as needed.

Important points to note:

- Only volunteers for game/concession crews will receive a badge for free entrance to games/contests; **volunteers are workers, not spectators!** All other family/friends must pay admission at the gate
- Only parents who have volunteered for game/concession crews should report to the band hall to receive their badges. All other family/friends should go directly to the stadium and remain in the stands
- For away games/contests, game crews may also be required to ride the buses as chaperones.
- Please exercise good sportsmanship at all times
